
Explore \$5M Hollywood-style retreat in Purchase

Ho-hum Purchase carriage house remade into a stylish 9,500-square-foot retreat

Samantha Berkowitz has spent the last 16 years transforming a very ordinary old carriage house in the Sky Meadow Farm development in Purchase into a Hollywood-style home with 9,489 square feet of lavishly decorated interior space.

Berkowitz has terrific taste and sense of space and she's obviously enjoyed every minute of enlarging, renovating and redecorating the six-bedroom, nine-bath house.

She picked the very best custom furniture, fabrics, appliances, electronic systems, and wall finishes and treatments. The walls in the formal living room are Venetian plaster. In the dining room, the walls are waxed and the ceiling is silver leaf. For most of the public rooms on the first floor, Berkowitz chose a lovely off-white

French limestone. Luxurious silk carpeting covers the master bedroom floor.

Some of the rooms are quite dramatic, with soaring ceilings and space for oversized art pieces and fixtures. "I want everything to feel organic and serene and sexy," she says.
